Picture-based discussions

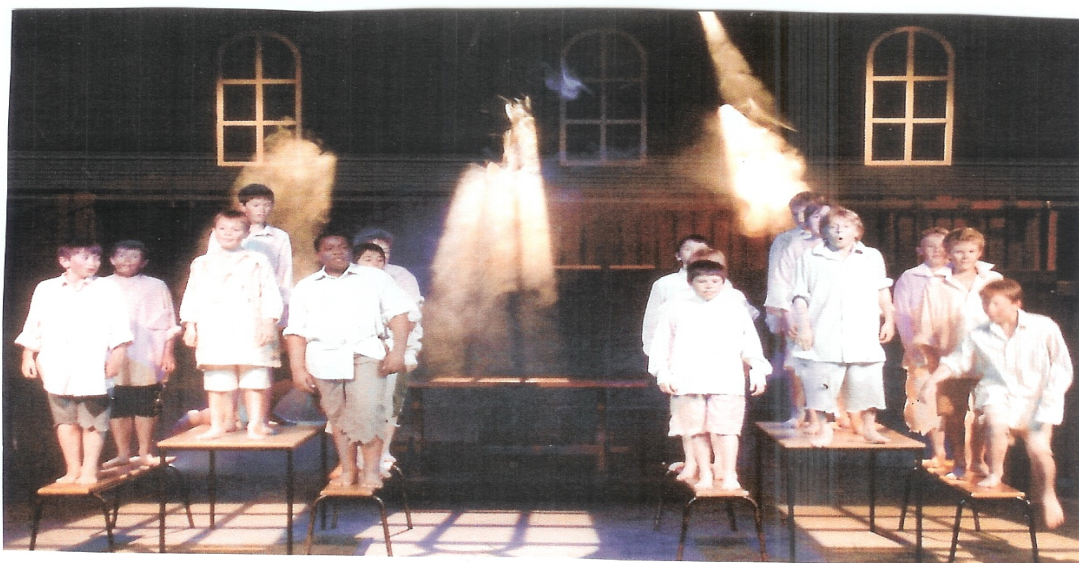

Below are examples of the types of pictures and questions that students may choose and refer to in their picture-based discussion tasks *Paper 2: Speaking* in **all languages**.

It is intended that the use of a student's picture will give candidates a sense of task ownership and that it will facilitate free discussion. However, teachers should interject with some open ended questions to ensure that students demonstrate an ability to adapt their discussion and to respond appropriately to their questions.

The examples used are for Spanish (with English translations below for review purposes only); Edexcel will produce exemplars with suggestions for questions in each target language.

TOPIC AREA : MEDIA AND CULTURE

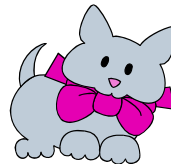






Your Chinese/ French/ German/ Italian/ Spanish/ Urdu-speaking pen friend, who is visiting you, wants to go to the cinema during the next week.
